Promoters Conditions and Meet Information

1. The promoter is Swim England East Midland Region
2. All communications will be electronic via the website www.emswimchamps.org.uk or email as appropriate.
3. The competition will be held long course at Moorways Sports Village, Derby, on 22nd and 23rd July 2023.
4. The event is open to all swimmers who are Club Compete members of any Swim England Affiliated Club.
5. Age is as at 23rd July 2023, minimum age for all swimmers including relays is 9yrs.
6. Closing date: Sunday 9th July 2023 (midnight) or when full.

7. Fees:
 - Individual per swim via SportSystems: £8
 - Individual per swim via Entry Form: £8.50
 - Relay: £12
 - Meet Accreditation: £8 per accreditation
8. Clubs or entrants will be invoiced for individual and relay entries as entries are accepted, payment must be received before the event.
Meet accreditations are payable via PayPal at time of purchase.
9. Although there are no qualification times for this competition, entrants must submit a time for entry, which is slower than our upper limit times as published to be accepted for this competition.
10. Times are not locked to rankings so coaches estimated times can be accepted.
11. Entries must be submitted by the club gala coordinator who is responsible for entering the swims electronically using the Sportsystems Entry Manager Program.
12. The meet is a first come first served meet and entries will be taken until the meet is full based on the length of sessions and then on a one-by-one basis to fill all lanes in heats. Venue capacity will also be taken into consideration.
13. The promoter reserves the right to limit entries should the gala capacity be exceeded.
14. The promoter reserves the right to consider late entries where space is available.
15. All individual events will be swum as mixed ages, results and awards (Top 3) will be given in each age band: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13/14, 15/Over.
16. Para-Swimming awards for swimmers classified S1-S14 will be given to the top 3 male and top 3 female swimmers in each event based on BPS points.
17. Relay awards will be given to the top 3 teams in the following age groups: 13/Under and 14/Over.
18. Awards not collected during the event will be forfeited.

19. SportySwim vouchers will be given to the Top Boy and Top Girl. Points 10-1 will be given based on placing within each age group/event.
20. All events, including relays, will be seeded in time order with the last heat of each event spearheaded.
21. Swimmers who wish to withdraw from events must complete the online withdrawal form by 6pm the evening before the session. Withdrawals will only be considered for a refund should the online withdrawal form be completed and medical evidence given.
22. There will be a secondary strobe available at this competition.
23. Meet Accreditations for Coaches, Team Managers and Chaperones will be available via: https://www.swimmingresults.org/member_options.
24. Clubs are required to cover within their individual risk assessments the required number of Coaches, Team Managers and Chaperones along with gender of these for their team for each session, the Region has placed the guidance on ratios [here](#) to ensure this guidance is accessible. Also included in this area is the minimum standard qualifications and requirements for the online accreditation system.
25. If the meet is cancelled for matters beyond our control, all entry fees and meet accreditation payments will be refunded. No other costs will be considered.
26. Any question arising, for which these conditions do not provide, shall be determined by the promoter.
